# What you should know....

- Students must be enrolled with full schedule every year
- Students must complete 4 credits after 11th grade
- Work/Study waiver must be due to hardship, approval needed
- Students may begin taking college classes during the summer of 10th grade, must be eligible
- Dual Enrollment - student enrolled in college classes
- Dual Credit - Student enrolled in high school/college classes
- Once registered for a course, it goes on transcript
- April 25th: Application deadline for **PGCC** Summer/Fall enrollment; Ongoing registration until classes are filled for **Bowie**
- Dual enrollment students are not eligible for financial aid
- No Developmental Course allowed
- PGCC southern county satellite campus at Oxon Hill HS

## PGCC

### Accuplacer

- Reading | 79+;
- Sentence Skills | 90+;
- College Level Math | 45+ AND Elementary Algebra | 82+

### SAT

- Evidence-Based Reading and Writing | 480+
- Mathematics | 530+ >

### ACT

- 21+ (in one of the following areas: Critical Reading, Writing, and/or Mathematics)

- Reading | 79+;

## SAT

- Critical Reading | 450+

# Qualifying Scores for Dual Enrollment BOWIE STATE

If students...

- Receive a minimum 2.5 GPA,
- Earn 6 credits toward degree, and
- Have a minimum 900 SAT score (Critical Reading and Math) or 19 ACT Composite, they will automatically be admitted to Bowie State University upon graduation.

# DUAL ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

## PGCC

- Must complete 10th Grade with at least 2.5 GPA
- Must meet eligibility
- Must enroll for approved courses only to receive credit
- Must pay cost of textbook and fees
- Must complete registration at least two/three weeks prior to semester begin
- Must have transportation
- May be required to pay 90% of tuition if student fails
- May take Traditional, face-to-face formats; Hybrid, which combines face-to-face and online, formats • On-line, after a student has successfully earned 6 credits at PGCC with a GPA of 2.5
- Dual enrollment students may not take weekender courses.

# Registration Process - PGCC

New students:

- Complete the online application (link sent to PGCCPS email)
- Submit application packet to guidance counselor:
  - PGCC Dual Enrollment Form with course selection & signatures
  - College placement exam score report (Accuplacer, SAT, ACT)
  - Copy of high school transcript from SchoolMax
  - SOAR online orientation certificate of completion

Incomplete packets will not be processed, notification will be emailed

# Registration Process - Bowie

- Complete 4 page application with required signatures
- Student must submit completed application packet directly to BSU contact
  - 3 page application
  - Accuplacer, SAT, or ACT scores
  - Transcript
